Eagle Design Group: Soaring with Solar Power



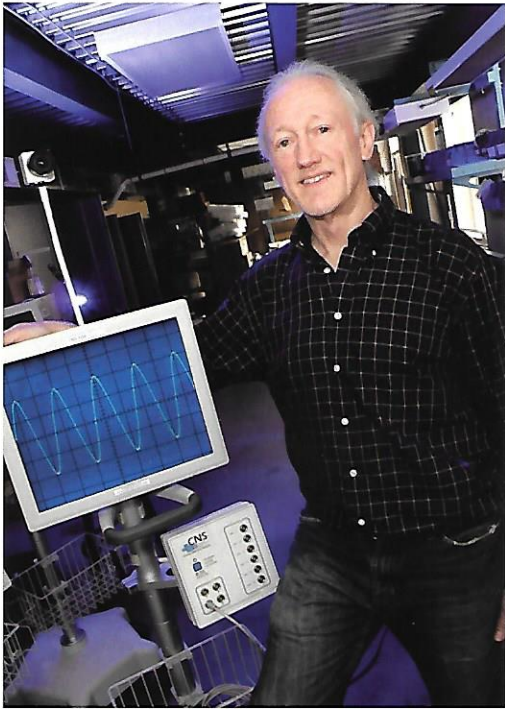
